### KEY TO CLEANING AGENT

1. Water
2. A Detergent Solution
3. A Detergent /Ammonia (3.6%) Solution
4. A Paint, Oil, or Grease remover
5. Oxalic or Citric Acids
6. A Volatile-type Solvent

### NOTE:

Chewing gum, candle wax, or similar waxy substance may be removed as follows: Rub the spot quickly with an ice cube so that the material becomes hard and blot dry. The brittle substance maybe then picked up from the carpet. Follow with a solvent cleaner as needed.

## CARE & CLEANSING INSTRUCTIONS

- Keep away from sharp objects & fire places.
- Never fold, or put your carpet in an airtight plastic bag !
- This rug is for indoor use only. Avoid using in damp areas such as basements, bathrooms and kitchens
- Exposure to direct sunlight may result in color fading. Rugs placed in daylight areas must be turned often.

## CARE & CLEANSING INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not pull the design elements.
- Remove spills immediately. Please find the guide on the adjacent label.
- Occasionally move heavy furniture to avoid pile from crushing.
- Hand brush or light vacuum regularly to prevent dust & crumbs from settling on the base of the rug. For the wool rugs, we recommend a suction only vacuum, so that it doesn't agitate the pile.
